This year's inductees are shining examples of the kind of loving dedication that so many have given to sports in Bay County. They have all played their games well. They have competed at the highest levels. They have dedicated a large portion of their life to the sport that they love.

We are pleased that you have chosen to attend and to share the glory of the moment. We have succeeded because of you and at the same time, for you.

Look around you. See and enjoy these faces in celebration.

History of The Bay County Sports Hall of Fame

In May of 1990, Denny Hayes became the first President of the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame ... according to the Articles of Incorporation filed that year with the State of Michigan.

Hayes, a Minnesota native and a former English teacher at Bay City Central High School during the early 1970's, was captivated by the sports enthusiasm and sports tradition he found in what has become to be called the Great Lakes Bay Region.

In 1973, Hayes retired from teaching and bought the Green Hut Tavern on Bay City's East side -- and set into motion a series of events that would (almost 20 years later) evolve into the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame (BCSHOF).

The BCSHOF was actually born in 1979 - at the Green Hut - when Hayes commissioned painter/artist, Dave Goss to produce large decorative sports murals for the walls inside Hayes' Columbus Avenue sports tavern. These murals depicted the athletic accomplishments of Olympic Gold Medal Speed skater (Essexville's) Terry McDermott, NFL football legend (Bay City's) Bill Hewitt and Major League Baseball's most-celebrated pinch-hitter, (Munger's) Jerry Lynch.

In those early years, according to Hayes, it was Dave Rogers, a Bay City *Times* editorial writer, who kept the ball rolling and first proposed that the concept of the Hall of Fame be taken to a county-wide level. Years passed with little activity. But, in the Fall of 1989, the concept of the Bay County Hall of Fame was revived again during a spontaneous meeting of Hayes, Rogers and local sports enthusiast, Jerry Spencer.

Weekly meetings followed as Tom Fallon (Bay City *Times*), Frank Walsh (WBCM), Herman Wolf, Barney Glowicki, Lee DeLorge and others became active members of the Hall of Fame Board of Directors. Momentum grew and the group moved their (monthly) meetings to the Bay County Community Center.

In March of 1990, the original set of by-laws were written and adopted. In May of 1990, Articles of Incorporation were filed with the State of Michigan and in August, through the efforts of Jerry Spencer, the Hall of Fame received formal 501 c (3) status as a non-profit organization operating in the State of Michigan.

Hayes stepped aside and Frank Walsh was elected by the original board of directors to serve as the BCSHOF's first President. Within two months, police officer Pete Kaczmarek, County Recreation Director Don Felske, Community Foundation Executive Glenda Kraft, former coach and school administrator Art Nixon, former *Sports Page* Newspaper Publisher O.J. Cunningham, businessman Harold Rupp and others became board members.

On the third Saturday of October in 1991, the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame held their first Induction Banquet at the Broadway House in Bay City. Honored were: Bill Hewitt, Johnny Tews, Nancy Kiesel, Terry McDermott, Jerry Lynch, Art Bakeraitis, Al Baker and Elmer Engel.

Each inductee received a personal plaque commemorating their Hall of Fame induction and a duplicate plaque was placed in the Hall of Fame display case at the Bay County Community Center on John F. Kennedy Drive in Bay City.

In 1992, the Hall of Fame commissioned local Bay County Historian Les Arndt to produce a 100 Year History of Sports in Bay County. In 1993, a second, revised edition was published and sold/distributed in the community. The book was used as a fund-raiser by the Sports Hall of Fame.

Lee DeLorge succeeded Frank Walsh as President of the Hall of Fame Board of Directors in 1992. Art Nixon served the next two terms as President (1993, 1994) and current President O. J. Cunningham was elected in 1995 and is currently serving his 19th full term as President of the BCSHOF organization.

In 1994, the Hall of Fame Board of Directors initiated a scholarship program to benefit scholar/athletes in the Bay County School system. Each year, the Hall of Fame Scholarship Committee reviews applications from scholar/athletes and presents a \$750 award to one student-athlete from each Bay County school. Schools include: Bay City Central, Bay City Western, Pinconning High School, Bangor John Glenn, Essexville Garber and Bay City All Saints. The program is now in its 20th year. Over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) dollars has already been distributed to deserving scholar-athletes.

In 1996, the Hall of Fame established the High School Team Award to honor scholastic teams that had achieved state-wide success in sports competition. The purpose was to recognize contributions that members of high school teams have made to the athletic heritage of the Great Lakes Bay Region. As of 2013, eighteen (18) high school teams (football, basketball, baseball, softball, cross country, volleyball and golf) have been honored.

In 1998, President O.J. Cunningham, with the approval of the Board of Directors, formed a Recreation ("REC") Team Committee and prepared a five-year plan to honor non-scholastic teams that had also competed statewide and had been recognized statewide for sports excellence.

In 1999, the Recreation Committee (Cunningham, Bob Adamowski and Vaughn Begick) presented their recommendation to the Board of Directors and in October of 1999, the 1981 Colt League Baseball All-Stars were inducted into the BCSHOF. More than thirty (30+) REC teams have been inducted as of 2013.

In 2004, the BCSHOF established the President's Award to honor individuals who have contributed "above and beyond" in terms of time and enthusiasm to the BCSHOF's stated agenda. BCSHOF President O.J. Cunningham was the first recipient of the Award which has been presented each year since 2004. (Yearly Award Winners are listed in this souvenir program book.)

In 2008, the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame Board of Directors proclaimed "Hockey Night in Bay County" as they inducted any and all players associated with team rosters of the Bay City Americans' Hockey who skated during the decades of the 1950s and 1960s at the Market Ice Rink on Columbus and Jefferson/Adams in Bay City.

In a similar move, at the 2013 banquet, the HOF Board inducted 14 Men/Women's Fastpitch Softball State Champions from the years 1949 through 1968. Eleven women's teams and three men's teams were included in the induction ceremony. An overflow crowd was on hand at the Doubletree in Bay City for the recognition of the legacy teams of Bay City Fastpitch.

The annual Bay County Sports Hall of Fame Induction Banquet is held at the Doubletree Hotel and Conference Center in Downtown Bay City, Michigan. The banquet is held on the first Sunday in October.

How It All Works

Anyone can nominate an individual for induction into the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame. Forms are available in the program book, may be obtained from Board Members, can be found at the annual induction banquet or on-line at baycountysports.com

Activity	Date	Explanation of Activity
Nomination and Screening	Jan/Mar	The HOF Screening Committee spends the first 3 months of the year reviewing existing folders of previous nominees and new suggestions submitted over the past 12 months. Background folders with supporting documentation must be on file for a person to be placed on the ballot.
Full Board Review	April	In April, the Screening Committee presents a docket of between 25 and 40 names to the full HOF Board of Directors for review. Two meetings are held in April and the list is pared down to approximately 25 names. These names are placed on the official ballot.
Ballots Mailed to Voting Life Members	May	In early May, the ballots are mailed along with an informational document to all voting members. Voting members include all current and past Board Directors, past inductees and all Life Members of the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame.
Ballots Counted	June	In a special meeting in June, Board members gather returned ballots mailed in by the voters and count them to determine who will be inducted.
Inductees Notified	July	In July, the top vote getters are notified by the Board of Directors and asked if they will accept.
Bay City Times	Aug/Sep	The Hall of Fame Board of Directors meets with the Sports Editor or representative of the Bay City Times and sets a schedule for photographs and weekly profiles of all elected inductees.
Banquet Preparation	Sep/Oct	Master of Ceremonies, Music, Ticket Sales, Program Advertising Sales, Plaques and Banquet Room Preparation are all organized during this time.
The Induction Banquet	October	The HOF Induction Banquet is held each year in October.

HALL OF FAME NOMINATIONS

**NOMINATION IS FIRST STEP TO INDUCTION
INTO THE BAY COUNTY SPORTS HALL OF FAME**

Nomination is the first step to being inducted into the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame (BCSHOF). No matter how significant the accomplishments of a team or an individual may be, a nomination is necessary in order for that person or team to be considered for induction to the BCSHOF and then placed on the ballot.

It should never be taken for granted that someone will be inducted. Do not assume that since you know all of the details concerning the greatness of a past legend, that this information is well known to everyone. Every year, members of the Hall of Fame Board of Directors have reviewed the files of hundreds of potential inductees, but there is no possible way that files on all qualified inductees could be gathered.

The nomination process is easy. All that is required is to submit the name of the team or individual on a Bay County Hall of Fame nominating form. In many cases, the Bay County Hall of Fame Board of Directors Nomination Screening Committee will do its own research on the candidates, but it is helpful to include the name of a contact person on the nomination form if additional information is required.





The Pub trailed 3-2 going into the final win-or-go-home shoot-out but erupted for four runs on three hits to take the lead 6-3. Pub then held strong as the Livonia team tried to rally from behind but fell short. Final Score: The Pub 6 - Livonia 4.

In the big Bay City Pub sixth inning, it was walks to Rena O'Brien and Dori Eager that got the rally started off on the right foot. Donna "Sorgenfrei" Gillard singled to load the bases and set the table for the sixth inning winning rally.

Shelly Hoerauf walked, forcing in the tying run. B.J. Roach followed with a single to score the go-ahead run and then Lisa Lentz singled to plate an insurance run with a fourth tally scoring when the Livonia defense threw the ball away attempting to cut down a Pub runner at the plate.

Livonia Oasis score one run in the bottom of the sixth but Bay City Pub claimed the championship game with a 6-4 final score win. Bay City The Pub scored their 6 runs on seven hits.

The Pub scored two runs in the opening inning to get their title game off to a good start. The Bay City girls put together walks to Hoerauf and Roach along with singles by Sheri Hardy and Jean Appold along with a Livonia error to get off to a 2-0 lead.

Centerfielder Sheri Hardy, second sacker Dori Eager and pitcher Donna "Sorgenfrei" Gillard were all named to the "All Tournament" All-Star Team.

Gillard was the winning pitcher in the "winner-take-all" championship game as she allowed only four runs while scattering 10 hits.

In the first game of the championship against Livonia Oasis, The Pub got singles by Jean Appold, Brenda Neumeyer, Rena O'Brien and Connie Reuther but fell short to set up the championship game.

PINCONNING, MI – It took three days, 20 innings and a record-setting performance.

But the Pinconning softball players walked off the field as victors, champions and legends.

With a state championship performance for the ages, the Spartans were crowned as 1993 Class B champs and cemented as one of the most storied teams of all-time. Now their legend grows with induction into the Bay County Sports Hall of Fame. Pinconning had already established itself as a statewide force by capturing its first state title in 1989, now it was looking for powerhouse status. Coach Ted Chapman's squad earned it, cruising to a 38-1 record while winning its seventh straight North East Michigan Conference crown and going back-to-back as district and regional champ. A 1-0 victory over Fenton completed the state title quest.

But it was how the Spartans won it that has fans and followers still marveling at the moment. Pinconning ace Angie Rosich and Fenton's Lisa Hillman refused to budge in a pitchers duel for all-time. And when rains moved in midway through Saturday final, the teams had to return to Battle Creek's Bailey Park on Monday to finish off the finale.

And a grand one it was. The game stretched to the 20th inning without a single run as the drama and tension soared with every swing.

Rosich, who went on to shine at Western Michigan University, would not be denied in delivering a dream performance in the pitchers circle. She allowed just two hits over 20 innings and struck out an eye-popping 32 batters – an MHSAA single-game record that still stands today.

Pinconning, meanwhile, had knocked 11 hits in the game but couldn't get the big one – until they got two big ones when it counted most. Kassie Mark singled in 20th inning, moved to second on a sacrifice by Kim Seyuin then raced home with the ice-breaker on a game-winning, two-out RBI single by Dana Bersano.

Bersano tied a state finals record with three hits in the game while Missy Chapman and Kim Henrion had two hits each.

It was a fitting finish to a spectacular campaign for Pinconning, which set a program record with a 31-game winning streak. Chapman, Henrion and Rosich all earned first-team all-state honors while Lane LeBourdais was named honorable mention.

All nine starters earned all-North East Michigan Conference accolades. Henrion led the team with a .516 batting average while Rosich set program records with 31 wins, 369 strikeouts and nine no-hitters.

The 1993 Pinconning softball team featured Jennifer Arndt, Dana Bersano, Jenny Bonnau, Missy Chapman, Sara Edwards, Kim Henrion, Danielle LaBarge, Lisa Lambert, Lane LeBourdais, Kassie Mark, Shannon McGillen, Jonelle Pajot, Angie Rosich, Stephanie Rotunno, Kim Seyuin and Misty VanHorn. Ted Chapman was head coach and Fred Neering served as assistant.
